Scrum is an agile project management framework that teams use to develop, deliver, and sustain complex products. It is a favorite framework for many development teams, as requirements change, goals change, situations change, scrum embraces those changes. It encourages teams to learn through experiences, self-organize while working on a problem, and reflect on their wins and losses to continuously improve
